SURVEY DESIGN:

- **International Social Survey Programme:** I was a founding co-principal investigator (with J. Kelley and Clive Bean) of the Australian edition of the ISSP in 1986, and our IsssA survey has run ISSP modules ever since. The ISSP now conducts annual surveys on a variety of topics in 25 nations: Australia, Austria, Britain, Bulgaria, Canada, the Czech Republic, France, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Malta, the Philippines, Poland, Russia, Slovenia, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden, and the United States. With J. Kelley, I developed the original proposal for the "social inequality" module and was co-convenor of the ISSP design team which developed the final questionnaire in each of its three rounds: 1987 (10 nations), in 1992 (22 nations), and 1999 (28 nations).
- **International Survey of Economic Attitudes:** I am co-principal investigator (with J. Kelley and Krzysztof Zagorski) of the ISEA since its inception in 1991. This repeated cross-sectional survey on public attitudes to the economy, government, and inequality so far includes six nations: Australia, Bulgaria, Finland, Hungary, the Netherlands, and Poland. We hope to add Brazil and the USA in the future.
- **International Social Science Survey/ Australia.** The IsssA is a project in the Melbourne Institute of Applied Economic and Social Research and the International Survey Center (Co-principal investigators: Prof. J. Kelley myself). Its goal is to expand sociological knowledge by developing new measurements on important issues; further, we seek to revise and improve existing measurement. We are also deeply involved in comparative measurement and analysis, collaborating with foreign colleagues in developing identical measurements that will allow precise international comparisons.

DATA PROVISION FOR STUDENTS AND COLLEAGUES

We maintain 2AF (Secondary Analysis Files) -- ready-to-use-right-out-of-the-box datasets -- from several of our articles on our website, with missing values declared and answers scored so that they can be used without recoding in analysis. These include the data from "The Legitimation of Inequality: Attitudes Towards

Inequality in Nine Nations" (AJS 1993), and "National Context, Parental Socialization, and Religious Belief: Results From 15 Nations" (ASR 1997). We are in the process of re-doing these because multiple imputation of missing data has recently emerged as a preferred approach and they had been constructed with the pairwise present approach in mind.
