With M.D.R. Evans, I have developed some easy-to-use data files designed for secondary analysis that can be downloaded directly from the Internet (at [www.international-survey.org](http://www.international-survey.org)) that enable students to begin by replicating some existing analyses that have been published in leading journals, and then to experiment with extending the analyses by adding new variables or using different estimation methods. The ease-of-use is an important feature, meaning that university teachers can incorporate “real” data analyses into courses where they would previously had to settle for “canned” examples.

Data from our web site ([www.international-survey.org](http://www.international-survey.org)) are being used in research and teaching throughout the world. They are being downloaded at the rate of about 600 datasets a year for the past five years.
